FOOTBALL TICKET INFORMATION

General Information

As you are probably aware, CSISD football stadiums will be limited to a maximum of 50% capacity and appropriate social distancing for games this season due to COVID-19 mitigation measures. All seats for public sale will be reserved, and no tickets will be available for sale at the gate. Prior to school closures this past spring, many fans had already purchased season tickets, and those tickets will be honored. We have developed a plan to offer any available seats to families of students participating in "Friday Night Lights." If you have already purchased season tickets, you are not eligible for additional ticket purchases. The football ticketing plan is detailed below.

Season Ticket Holders

For those of you who have already purchased season tickets, please know that due to social distancing requirements, you will likely not have the same seats you have had in previous years. Please pick up your tickets according to the schedule below.

Sale of Remaining Tickets

A limited number of tickets remain to meet the 50% capacity and social distancing mandated by the University Interscholastic League. Any family who has already purchased season tickets are not eligible for additional ticket purchases. These tickets will be sold following the priority list below and limited to two tickets per purchase.

- Parents of senior band members, drill team members, and cheerleaders
- Parents of underclass VARSITY football players
- Parents of underclass band members, drill team members, and cheerleaders

What if I do not get tickets?

Unfortunately, there are likely some who will not be able to attend games because of current capacity limitations set forth by the University Interscholastic League. As such, we are currently working on a plan to allow season ticket holders to surrender their tickets for resale should they not be able to attend a game. This process will likely be done on a week-to-week basis and we will provide more information on this as the plan is developed.

Live Stream

 For the first time, the University Interscholastic League will allow football games to be live streamed. Both AMCHS and CSHS will produce a live stream broadcast, which will include the half-time performances. More information on accessing the live stream will be available soon.

Student Tickets-School Cafeteria

The student sections will also follow the guidelines that promote social distancing and limit capacity. Student tickets will be sold on a priority basis beginning with seniors and limited to one ticket per purchase. Campuses will communicate student ticket purchase details directly to students on a weekly basis.

Road Games

Depending on the opponent, they will allocate a pre-determined number of tickets for sale to road games.

Game Procedures

- Spectators will be required to complete a COVID-19 screening upon entry. Fans are encouraged to arrive early to avoid lines.
- All spectators 10 years of age or older must wear face coverings upon entry to an area where UIL activities are being conducted.
- All seats will be marked and ticketed. Fans will be required to sit in their ticketed seat.
- UIL has sternly warned districts that failure to comply with the above requirements could result in suspension of UIL activities at a particular school. As such, failure to comply with these requirements will result in removal from the stadium.
